Zoë's Place Baby Hospice, Liverpool, provides palliative, respite and end of life care for poorly babies and terminally ill children aged 0-5 years, whilst also providing one to one, 24 hour nursing care in our 6 bedded hospice.

We provide bereavement support to families who have used our services in the past or new families who have been referred to us. Anyone who loses a child (under the age of 6) has access to this service.

We need to raise **£1.6 million** each year just to keep the doors of our hospice open.

As with all children's hospices we receive a modest amount of funding from the NHS and central Government. This funding is very important to us as the service to the families is provided entirely free of charge, but, it only goes a small way towards the costs of running the hospice. The reality is that Zoë's Place relies almost entirely on donations from our supporters.

We need your help to continue the running of our hospice and to provide vital care.



Here are just some of our costings in the hospice:

£4,500 a day for maintenance, equipment & staffing

Specialist beds costing **£7,000-£12,000** each

Maintaining our Hydrotherapy pool per year costs **£6'026**

£720 per P Pod; a specialist moulded & manoeuvrable seat

Physiotherapy for 1 day a week costs **£10,000** per year

Art Therapy costs an incredible **£12'480** per year

1 height adjustable multi-bath costs **£5,250**
