- B - Bingo - Create a fun bingo night! Whether it's themed around music, food, or classic numbers, a bingo event is a fun way to engage friends and raise money.
- B - Bike Ride - Organize a sponsored bike ride—whether solo or with a group. Set up an online fundraising page to get people involved in supporting Zoe's Place.
- B - Birthday Fundraising - Instead of gifts, ask for donations to Zoë's Place. A meaningful way to celebrate your special day and make a difference.
- C - Concert - Host a concert featuring local talent, or showcase your own! Charge for admission, with proceeds going to support our hospice.
- D - Dress-Up Day - Encourage your workplace or school to dress up for a day. Set a theme—fancy dress, superheroes, or just something fun—and donate to participate.
- E - Easter Egg Hunt - Hold an Easter egg hunt for the kids, with entry fees going to Zoe's Place. Perfect for springtime fun!
