

Robyn has Spina Bifida, kyphosis of the spine and a shunt. Her conditions mean she has no feeling from the waist down, but that doesn't stop her. Even though 'she has been through quite a lot,' Steph, Robyn's Mum, explains, 'she dead strong and happy all the time. Even when she's sick, she's always smiling...She's just a little warrior.'






